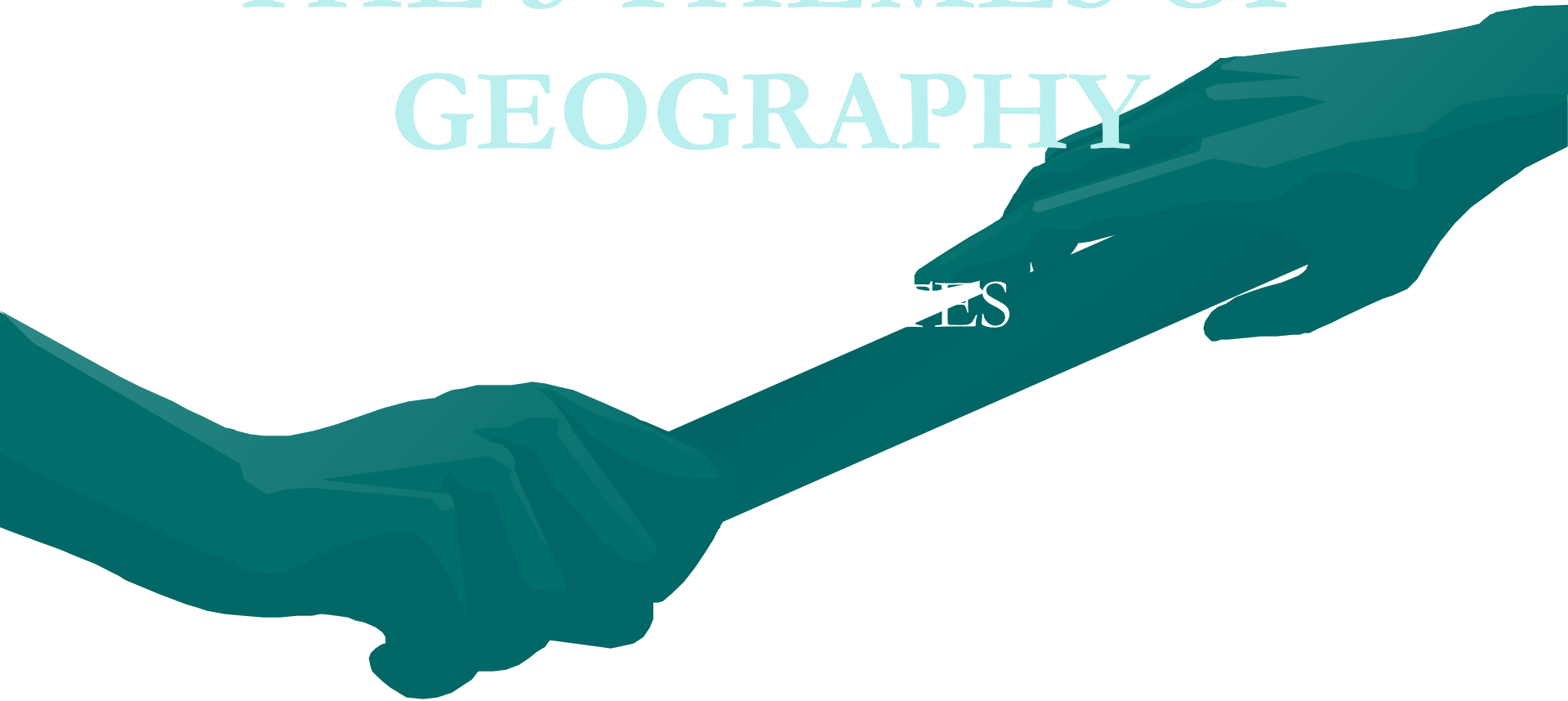

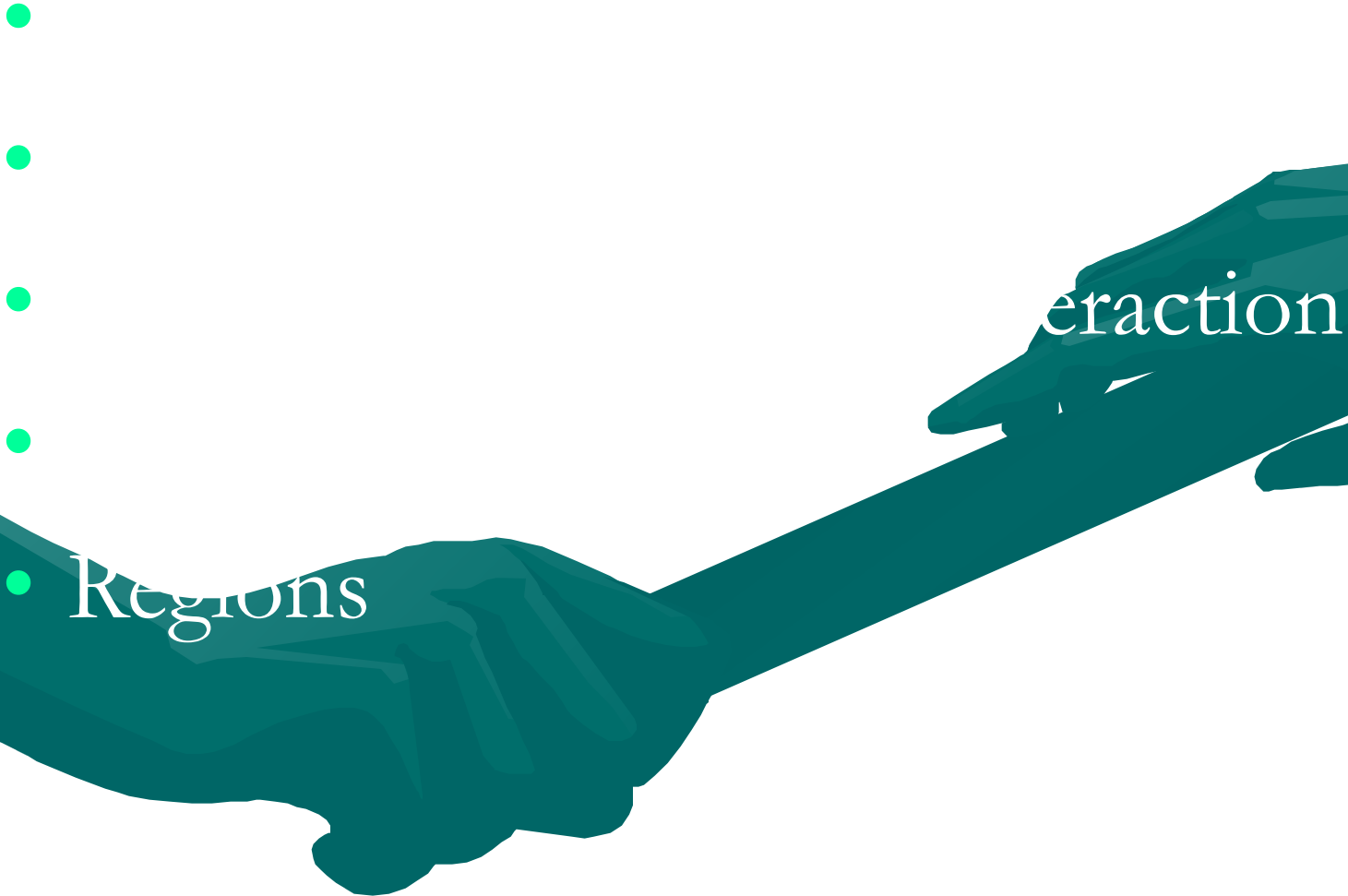

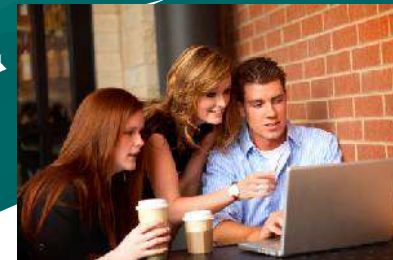

REGIONS

- Regions defined by political boundaries (States, Counties, etc.).
- Regions defined by economic activities (Corn Belt, Rocky Mountain West, etc.).
- Regions defined by a function (newspaper circulation, television coverage area).
- Vernacular Regions (People's Regions)
 - Regions defined by people's perceptions of regional identity.
