Policy #: 5140

Soliciting

No person will sell or offer for sale within a school building or on school property any articles or services or solicit contributions except those approved by the Superintendent or the Board of Education. This policy does not prohibit any school fund-raising activity authorized by the school administration.

Salespeople are prohibited from talking to teachers at any time during the school day except salespeople representing educational companies may be granted this opportunity, by making arrangements through the principal's office, at a time that is convenient and will not interfere with the classroom work of the teacher.

The school directory or lists of students and staff will not be made available to any outside person or agency-

Distribution of Literature

Non-school-related printed or written matter of any nature will not be permitted to be distributed to students in the schools or on school grounds without prior approval of the Superintendent or designee. In cases where the nature of the material or its ultimate intent are in doubt, it will be presented to the Board of Education for approval or denial.

Advertising

No notices or advertisements by or in behalf of persons not officially connected with the schools will be distributed in any school building except by permission of the Superintendent or Board. All notices, even by school personnel, will be cleared by the building principal and, in case of doubt, by the Superintendent or designee.
