Attendance / Tardies / Early Checkouts

Overwhelming evidence indicates that student success is directly related to regular student attendance. Poor attendance refers to students who are absent as well as to students who are tardy or leave school prior to the end of the school day. High performing students have an average of less than three days absent or tardy in a school year. At South Woods, we continue to strive for excellence with our students and staff. Currently our school has among the highest absenteeism rate in the school district.
