Make a mind map that shows the parts of your folk tale (2 pts.)	Create a timeline of clues or information found in your novel. (2 pts.)	Illustrate and design a book jacket for your book. Include the name of the author and illustrator. Also include a “teaser” summary on the back of the jacket inviting readers to read the book. (2 pts.)	Create a collage of pictures related to the topic of your nonfiction selection (2 pts.)	Choose 8 significant events in the life of the person you read about. Using these dates create a timeline of the person’s life. (2pts)	Design an acrostic for your favorite character. Use character traits for each letter of his or her name. (2pts.)
Make a set of trading cards for the main characters in your folk tale (2pts)	Create a collage of pictures that could represent the characters and events in your novel. (2 pts.)	Create a board game about your book. Include characters, setting, and details from the story in your game. Turn in a sample of the game with your choice board. (2 pts.)	Design a quiz to quiz your classmates about your topic, minimum of 10 questions. (2 pts.)	Create 5 Facts and a Fib about the person in your biography. (2 pts.)	Create a book cover for your novel. Include a picture and back cover summary (2pts.)
Pretend that you are one of the characters in your folk tale. Retell the folk tale from your point of view using expressive language (5 pts.)	Complete the mystery story map for your novel. See your teacher for a copy. (5 pts.)	Write a song or a rap that summarizes your story. You may use a familiar tune or make up one of your own. (5 pts.)	Write a song or a rap to help teach others about your topic. It should include at least 10 details about your topic. (5 pts.)	Write a journal entry about an important life lesson you learned while reading about the individual and how it will help you in the future. (5 pts.)	Create a character mobile. Place all of the characters on the mobile and include 1 trait for each Under each trait, select a supporting quote from the novel. (5 pts.)
Create a book cover for a folk tale of your choice. (5 pts.)	Write a newspaper article that may have been written about the mystery or crime committed in your novel. (5 pts.)	Write a play or skit that depicts a scene from your book. Please type or print your script, listing characters and special stage directions. (5 pts.)	Design a crossword puzzle using information provided in the nonfiction work you selected. (5pts.)	Famous athletes are not the only people who can be featured on a cereal box. After reading your biography, design a cereal box for your person. (5 pts.)	Design a personality collage for 2 of your favorite characters from the novel (they do NOT have to be the main characters. Include at least 10 words and/or pictures for each. (5 pts.)
Pretend you are a character in your folk tale. Write 5 journal entries that tell about your adventure. (8 pts.)	Using the mystery story map to brain storm, create and write your own mystery or suspense story. (8 pts.)	Create a crossword or word search. Find at least 10 difficult or interesting words in your book. Create a crossword or word search. (8 pts.)	Use facts from your nonfiction book to create a museum exhibit. Include a written description explain the items or pictures you have in the exhibit. (8 pts.)	Come to class as the person in your biography. Share the top two ways you have impacted the world and made it a better place. (8 pts.)	The Book Hall of Fame is taking nominations. Design a PowerPoint to submit your book for this honor. Must have 10 slides (8 pts.)
Create your own folk tale. Include a story map and rough draft of your ideas. (8 pts.)	Make a wanted poster for the villain in your story. Include things like a picture of the villain, their crimes, and the reward amount. (8 pts.)	Make a collage from magazines or a newspaper that represents what happened in the story. Illustrate character, problem, solution, setting and events in your story. (8 pts.)	Create a brochure that shares important details about your topic, why you chose it, and how it relates to your everyday life. (8 pts.)	Write an autobiography about your life and your accomplishments. Make one page per year. (8 pts.)	Create a windowpane with at least 10 panes for the theme of the novel. In each pane place a quote from different parts of the story to explain the theme. (8pts.)
