What will I need for my 5th grade specials?

All 5th grade students will be scheduled for Health, Keyboarding, and Physical Education. Students will have a choice of two of the following specials: Band, Chorus, Spanish, STEM, Visual Arts.

Pencil and paper will be needed for all special courses.

Below is an overview of the courses and additional needed supplies:

Band 	<p>In 5th grade band your student receives instruction on one of the following instruments of the student's choice: flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, tenor saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, baritone, and percussion. Each student should have two choices of instruments, a primary and secondary. This is to maintain the size of each section. Information on how to rent/obtain an instrument will be given by the instructor at the beginning of the school year.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Instrument and accessories required for your instrument, Essential Elements or Essential Elements 2000 Bk 1 for your instrument, 2 Pocket folder for worksheets, Pencils</p>
Chorus 	<p>Chorus instruction in 5th grade includes reading choral sheet music, ear training, choral techniques, and etiquette. Basic music theory with analysis along with an emphasis on learning to control and blend the voice.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Two pocket folder with three brads, pencils</p>
Health 	<p>In this course we will explore the importance of personal care, learn about Erin's Law, discuss mental/emotional health, and cover a drug unit.</p> <p>No additional supplies needed.</p>
Keyboarding 	<p>We will learn how to use the touch method of keyboarding – no peeking!! We will also learn about computer and word processing basics, along with internet safety.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Two pocket folder (Mr. Layton only) (No additional supplies for Mrs. Macrides or Mrs. Smith)</p>
Physical Education 	<p>In this class students will be working on physical skills used for small-sided games and team sports. They will also be working on fitness skills to help promote lifelong fitness.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Sneakers with laces</p>
Spanish 	<p>This is an exploratory Spanish course where you will acquire all the basics needed for Spanish 1.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Pencils, paper, composition book</p>
STEM 	<p>S.T.E.M. class will immerse students in all areas of S.T.E.M. learning. This interdisciplinary curriculum will integrate all the S.T.E.M. disciplines by using project-based, problem-based learning, creative and physical computing. Students will solve problems, innovate, and create!</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> 1/2' 3 Ring Binder, dividers, notebook paper, glue stick, scissors</p>
Art 	<p>In this course, students will learn about artistic processes and techniques using a wide variety of different materials. They will also learn ways in which artists all around the world convey ideas, thoughts, and emotions in their work, and students will learn how to incorporate those same modes of expression in their art.</p> <p><u>Additional Supplies Needed:</u> Colored pencils, markers, sharpie, glue sticks, pencils, erasers, tissues, hand soap, aluminum foil, zipper pencil case</p>
