# Grading Policy

#### SUMMATIVE - 80%

Summative grades will include assignments/assessments such as tests and projects which are used to determine student mastery of standards after a unit of learning has been completed. This grade is reported separately and will account for 80% of the final semester average.

### FORMATIVE - 20%
