## 80 points

- Create a website that takes questors on a journey through the key people & events of the New South Era. Include the following: Bourbon Triumvirate, Henry Grady, International Cotton Exposition, Rebecca Latimer Felton, Tom Watson, Booker T. Washington, W.E.B. DuBois, John & Lugenia Hope, Alonzo Herndon and how these people & events impacted Georgia & the country. Use [www.weebly.com](http://www.weebly.com). It is free to create an account.
- Create an advertisement to entice in-state visitors, out-of-state visitors, potential businesses, etc. to the International Cotton Exhibition. Be sure to include the attractions Georgia (particularly Atlanta) possess. The message should be clear, concise and obvious. There should also be a written report to explain the predicted impact the International Cotton Exposition will have in Georgia socially, economically, and politically. The report should be on paper (approximately 2-3 paragraphs). The advertisement should be at least 8.5" by 11". A slogan should be included. Color picture. Include prices where appropriate.
- Report on the 1906 Atlanta Riot or the Leo Frank case. Your news format may be written (newspaper) or video (television) and should be a clear, concise and factual relating of the events that took place. If written, make sure that it is typed in column format and includes a headline and at least one picture. It may be more than one article and include various points of view (editorials) in addition to the factual reporting of the event. It should be 1 page typed or neatly written. If recorded, it should be done in the style of a real newscast (written script along with appropriate dress and set). It should be at least 5 minutes in length, and if editing is possible include at least one picture. Script should be typed or neatly written.
- Create a political cartoon depicting the vision/message of the Bourbon Triumvirate, Henry Grady, Rebecca Latimore Felton, Booker T. Washington, or W.E.B. Dubois. Remember this is a cartoon not a short story. The expectations are that it be colorful, eye-catching, have a clear message, and consist of at least 2 scenes. No more than 8 words are allowed.
