### ELA -

This week in ELA, students will receive ten new vocabulary words and read the science fiction drama, "Sorry, Wrong Number." Then, students will complete various activities about the drama which includes highlighting the dramatic elements of the text, identifying critical symbols of the plot, explicating the overall theme, composing an original narrative, rewriting the ending of the text, and/or comparing and contrasting the visual adaptation to the text.
