### STEP 1- SELECT YOUR ACADEMIC PATH

SSA offers two Academic Paths for students to choose.

#### Traditional Academic Path

- Traditional Academic Path in 7th grade offers students the choice to select the level of Language Arts and/or Math
- Science and Civics are standard for all Traditional Academic Path students
- 7th Grade Traditional Academic Classes include:
  - Choice of ELA: Language Arts 2 standard or Language Arts 2 Advanced
  - Choice of Math: Math 2 standard, Math 2 Advanced, Algebra Honors (HS Credit)
  - Civics standard
  - Comprehensive Science 2 standard
  - Emerging Leaders (semester)
  - PE (semester)

### STEP 1- SELECT YOUR ACADEMIC PATH

#### SCPS Pre-IB Program Path

- The SCPS Pre-IB Program Path provides rigorous and extensive course study in math, science, world language, social studies, and language arts with an emphasis on independent study, in-depth learning, and accelerated curriculum requirements.

- 3.0 Overall GPA required to remain in SCPS Pre-IB.
- 7th grade SCPS Pre-IB classes include:
  - SCPS Pre-IB Language Arts 2 Advanced
  - SCPS Pre-IB Civics Advanced
  - SCPS Pre-IB Comprehensive Science 2 Advanced
  - Choice of math: Advanced Math 2 or Algebra H \*HS credit
  - World Languages 2 (required semester elective)
  - Emerging Leaders (semester)
  - PE (semester)

### STEP 2- ELECTIVES

- -Elective choices may be removed based on FSA scores and the need for students to take reading and/or intensive math.
- -All 7th grade students are **required** take the following electives (you will not need to select these on Google Doc):
  - Emerging Leaders (semester)
  - Physical Education (semester) (PE waiver available here)
  - SCPS Pre-IB students will be scheduled into World Languages 2

#### -iSeries

- -SCPS Middle School students are required to take iJourney for middle school promotion- students that did not take it in 6th grade, will be scheduled into it in 7th grade
- -Students must additionally take one more iSeries class: iChallenge or iConnect --->it is recommended that this is taken in 7th grade, but required to take by the end of middle school.

- -Electives are either year long (year) or semester (semester).
- -High school courses are indicated with \*HS
- -Pre-requisites are indicated with (PR)

# Information on High School Level Courses

- -If struggling in a high school level course, such as Algebra Honors, it must be dropped before the first 9 weeks so that it does not appear on the high school transcript.
- -If a student earns C's or below in a high school credit course they may retake the course for grade forgiveness through their assigned high school or virtual school.
- -Algebra Honors and Geometry Honors will transfer as an elective credit, not a math credit, which means that four years of math in high school is still required.
