LCMS Behavior Guidelines & Agreement

8th grade dance 6:30 PM to 9:30 PM on May 21st, 2022

Students attending the 8th Grade Dance are expected to follow the rules and guidelines listed below throughout the evening. Failure to follow the provided rules may result in a reduction or loss of privileges and/or disciplinary consequences in line with the SCPS code of conduct. *Any 8th grade student who has received 2 or more disciplinary referrals or a referral resulting in a suspension in the second semester (January – May 2022) is ineligible to attend this event.*

- Students are expected to use appropriate, respectful language and follow the behavior guidelines within the Seminole County Code of Student Conduct at all times.
- Dress Attire for the dance is as follows: Khaki/Slacks, Button-up Shirts, Dresses (must be appropriate in length and fit). Cocktail or floor length dresses are acceptable, as well as spaghetti straps/strapless dresses.
- Hagerty High School's dress shop THE HAUTE HUSKY is open for all 8th grade students offering free dresses.
- Student "check in" for the dance will be on the **car ramp** at 6:30 pm no bus ramp drop off permitted.
- Student "pick up" after the dance will be on the **car ramp** at 9:30pm no bus ramp drop off permitted.
- Students may not bring backpacks or large bags. Small purses measuring 8.5" x 5.5" or smaller are permitted.
- All students in attendance must enter at car ramp and exit at the car ramp.
- Light refreshments will be served at the dance (mini cupcakes, cake pops, mini brownies, chip bags, donut holes and water cups). Water bottles and goody bags will be handed out as the students leave the event.
- DONATIONS ARE NEEDED: Cases of water bottles and individually wrapped candy can be dropped off at front office prior to the dance.
- VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED: To help set up before dance and clean up after dance. SIGN UP GENIUS will be sent to all 8th grade parents.
- Tickets go on sale **May 2nd** and can be purchased for \$15 through **MySchoolBucks** until May 13th, 2022. Cash and checks are not accepted.
- This event is only open to LCMS 8th grade students in good standing.
