

8TH GRADE DANCE DRESS CODE

The Eighth Grade Dance is a special event that we all look forward to each year. We have put together the following dress code guidelines so that you can prepare ahead of time while shopping for appropriate attire.

Students are able to wear:

- A dress or gown that is “suitable” by covering the chest, torso, and undergarments. It must also follow the district’s guidelines of not being shorter than four inches above the knee, and must remain appropriate length during movement. Dresses must also have straps (either two straps over the shoulder or one strap secured around the neck).
- Dress pants that are secured at the waist
- Collared dress or polo style shirt
- A tie and/or jacket (optional).

Students will not be admitted into dance wearing cargo pants, denim, jeans, t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, canes, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products.

Only students meeting the dress requirements listed above will be admitted to the dance. If you have questions or concerns regarding attire, it is your responsibility to speak with an administrator. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before the evening of the dance. If you arrive at the dance dressed inappropriately, you will be asked to leave or change before being allowed into the dance. **A refund will not be granted.**



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
