### Extended Day #1: October 21, 2019

I-fly Indoor Skydiving, Southern Rail Museum and Kennesaw Mountain Civil War Battlefield Price: \$115.00 per student

- Tour the grounds of Historic Kennesaw Mountain.

**Southern Rail Museum:** Home of the General, the famous locomotive from the Civil War. Students will follow the Confederate soldiers as they chase down this stolen locomotive. Exhibits will include a look at how trains were used for economic and war strategy during the Civil War.

**Kennesaw Mountain Civil War Battlefield:** Step back in time to the Civil War and explore the battlefields. Students will explore the same land that the soldiers walked during the Atlanta Campaign of 1864. The climb to the overlook will offer a view of the land that General Sherman and his armies famously traveled on their March to the Sea. \*\*\*Bring bug spray and water bottle and wear tennis shoes

**I-Fly Skydiving:** iFly allows people to experience flying without jumping out of an airplane! During the field trip students will get fired up about math and physics when they see it come to life in a state-of-the-art wind tunnel.
