Gradventure Behavior Guidelines May 19th, 2023

Students attending Gradventure are expected to follow the rules and guidelines listed below throughout the scheduled field trip, including while on the bus. Failure to follow provided rules may result in a reduction or loss of privileges on the trip and/or disciplinary consequences in line with the SCPS code of conduct upon return to school.

- All students will be required to remain in the dress code established by Universal Orlando throughout the event. This includes shorts/skirts being no shorter than mid-thigh and secured at the waist. Students will be required to wear their provided Millennium field trip t-shirt. T-shirts may not be cut or altered in any way. A full dress code from Universal Orlando will be provided to students two weeks prior to the trip.

- Students will be assigned a student group with a chaperone. Students will remain with their group and chaperone throughout the event.

- Students may not bring backpacks or large bags on the trip. Small purses measuring 8.5" x 5.5" or smaller are permitted, if necessary.

- All students will be required to pass through Universal Orlando security screening. This includes bag checks and metal detectors.

- Universal Orlando requires that all students and chaperones remain in the park until the event ends. No students will be permitted to depart early.

- Students are expected to use appropriate, respectful language and always follow the behavior guidelines within the Seminole County Code of Student Conduct at all times.

- All student groups will be required to check-in at a central location and take attendance at a designated time and location during the event.

- If you get a referral in the 2nd semester you are not able to attend the event.
