### STEP 1- SELECT YOUR ACADEMIC PATH

SSA offers two Academic Paths for students to choose.

#### **Traditional Academic Path**

- Traditional Academic Path in 8th grade offers students the choice to select the level of Language Arts, Math, Science, and History
- 8th Grade Traditional Academic Classes include:
  - Choice of ELA: Language Arts 3 standard or Language Arts 3 Advanced
  - Choice of Math: Pre-Algebra, Algebra Honors (HS Credit), or Geometry Honors (HS credit, PR: Alg H)
  - US History standard or US History Advanced
  - Comprehensive Science 3 standard or Comprehensive Science 3 Advanced
  - Leadership elective required (see Step 2A)
  - PE (semester)

#### STEP 1- SELECT YOUR ACADEMIC PATH

#### SCPS Pre-IB Program Path

- The SCPS Pre-IB Program Path provides rigorous and extensive course study in math, science, world language, social studies, and language arts with an emphasis on independent study, in-depth learning, and accelerated curriculum requirements.

- 3.0 Overall GPA required to remain in SCPS Pre-IB.
- 8th grade SCPS Pre-IB classes include:
  - SCPS Pre-IB Language Arts 3 Advanced
  - SCPS Pre-IB US History Advanced
  - Environmental Science Honors (HS Credit)
  - Choice of math: Algebra H (HS credit) or Geometry Honors (HS credit, PR: Alg H)
  - SCPS Pre-IB Spanish 1 (required year elective)
  - PE (semester)

### STEP 2- ELECTIVES

-Elective choices may be removed based on FSA scores and the need for students to take reading and/or intensive math.

#### <u>iSeries</u>

- -SCPS Middle School students are required to take iJourney for middle school promotion-students that did not take it previously, will be scheduled for it in 8th grade
- -Students must additionally take one more iSeries class: iChallenge or iConnect
- -Students that have not met the second iSeries requirement will need to select one on the Google Doc, or one will be selected for them
- -All 8th grade students are **required** take Physical Education (semester) and will be automatically scheduled for the course (PE waiver available <a href="here">here</a>)

### STEP 2A- SELECT YOUR LEADERSHIP ELECTIVE

-8th grade students in the SCPS Pre-IB program will automatically meet this requirement by taking the Spanish Pre-IB course- please select "SCPS Pre-IB student."

- -Students that do not submit their Course Selection Google Doc will have courses selected by a school counselor- don't miss your opportunity to have a say in your courses!

# Information on High School Level Courses

- -If struggling in a high school level course, such as Algebra Honors, it must be dropped before the first 9 weeks so that it does not appear on the high school transcript.
- -If a student earns C's or below in a high school credit course they may retake the course for grade forgiveness through their assigned high school or virtual school.
- -Algebra Honors and Geometry Honors will transfer as an elective credit, not a math credit, which means that four years of math in high school is still required.
