You will need to maintain a composition notebook. When you sit down to read, whether it is for five minutes or an hour, we want you to write down a brief paragraph of your thoughts on what you have read. You should include literary elements such as theme, characterization (direct and non-direct), conflict, setting, protagonist, antagonist, rising action, falling action, resolution, climax, and point of view, these are among the many literary elements that exist in addition to symbols, and allusions which should also be included. You will find these elements in the setting, plot, or even the characters. The elements do not need to be discussed every time you make an entry, but you should be able to address all of the elements by the time you finish the novel.

There is not an additional writing requirement other than the journal entries, but there will be a baseline assessment of the novel to gauge your understanding of literary elements and comprehension. When we collect the composition books to read them, your journal should convey to us that you have done a careful reading of the book.

Composition books are due on August 30th.
