





# **GRADVENTURE:**

- LOCATION: UNIVERSAL STUDIOS /UNIVERSAL ISLANDS OF ADVENTURE
- When: May 6<sup>th</sup> 2022 Depart CSRMS after lunch and return @ appxt 2:30-3:00 AM on Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup>
- NOTE: DRESS CODE STILL APPLIES & STUDENTS <u>MUST</u> WEAR THE 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE T-SHIRT ON THE TRIP WITH NO ALTERATIONS.
- Cost: \$150.00 Due by Friday, April 1<sup>st</sup> Please note that space is limited and will be filled on a first come first served basis
- Included: Transportation to/from, admission to Universal Studios/Islands of Adventure, the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade T-shirt, a souvenir bag, as well as one meal voucher while at the park.
- ELIGIBILITY: MUST MAINTAIN BEHAVIORAL ELIGIBILITY FROM JANUARY 22<sup>ND</sup> THROUGH MAY 6<sup>TH</sup> AND MUST MEET ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY BY APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> AND MUST MAINTAIN ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY BETWEEN APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> AND MAY 6<sup>TH</sup> IN ORDER TO ATTEND THIS TRIP. STUDENTS WHO LOSE THEIR ELIGIBILITY STATUS FOR ANY REASON BETWEEN APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> AND MAY 6<sup>TH</sup> WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND AND WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND FOR THE TRIP AS A TICKET WILL HAVE BEEN PURCHASED AND THE STUDENT WILL HAVE BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR FROM A TRANSPORTATION STANDPOINT. (UNLESS WE ARE ABLE TO USE THEIR SPOT FOR A STUDENT ON THE WAITING LIST)

Academic
Behavioral

## **ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY:**

1) Have to be eligible for promotion to HS to participate in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Events A) at the time that the ticket is purchased

- B) at the time of the event
- If you are not eligible we will not sell you a ticket or take your \$
- If you lose your eligibility we will not allow you into the event and your \$ will not be refunded (unless we can find a student to take your spot)

#### You Are Academically Ineligible, if:

You failed an 8<sup>th</sup> Grade core class (LA, MA, Sci, SS) for the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Semester</u>
<u>Or</u> Your 1<sup>st</sup> Semester average when combined with your 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter grades results in a grade that is less than 60% for year

2) You have previously failed a 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grade core class (LA, MA, Sci, SS) for the year and have not recovered the class

3) You are enrolled in an eSchool/FLVS core class and are not at least Completed with Segment 1 & 50% completed with Segment 2 at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Q with a grade less than 60%

### HOW TO BECOME ELIGIBLE:

- 1) Recover <u>ALL</u> previously failed 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> Grade Core Classes through Course Recovery/ESD
- 2) Bring <u>ALL</u> of your 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Core Classes to a 60% or higher for the EOY Average
- If you are not eligible we will not sell you a ticket or take your \$
- If you lose your eligibility we will not allow you into the event and your \$ will not be refunded

#### You Are Academically Ineligible, if:

You failed an 8<sup>th</sup> Grade core class (LA, MA, Sci, SS) for the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Semester</u>
<u>Or</u> Your 1<sup>st</sup> Semester average when combined with your 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter grades results in a grade that is less than 60% for year

2) You have previously failed a 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grade core class (LA, MA, Sci, SS) for the year and have not recovered the class

3) You are enrolled in an eSchool/FLVS core class and are not at least Completed with Segment 1 & 50% completed with Segment 2 at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Q with a grade less than 60%

### **OPPORTUNITIES TO BECOME ELIGIBLE:**

1). **Course Recovery** – offered 6 periods/day – replaces an elective class and is located in the Media Center – Mrs. Shipp & Mr. Doychak run the lab and are there to provide support/assistance – Students complete the APEX course recovery materials (Depending on the time of year and the students specific situation, we may be able to offer a 2<sup>nd</sup> period of Course Recovery)

2). <u>Extended School Day</u> – offered on Mondays & Wednesdays from 1:50-3:20 in the Media Center – Mrs. Belisle and Mr. Doychak are the staff in charge of ESD – Students complete the APEX course materials in order to recover the courses in need of recovery – Transportation is NOT provided

3). <u>Pass your classes</u> – Go talk to your teachers and ask for help! Do not miss assignments! Zeroes have a terribly negative effect on your grade!

### **BEHAVIORAL ELIGIBILITY:**

1) 100% of you are eligible as of today based on behavior!

- 2) If you get ISS:
- you will lose eligibility for the **<u>NEXT</u>** event
  - we will not sell you a ticket or take your \$ for that event
  - If you already bought your ticket, we will not allow you into the event and your \$ will not be refunded (unless we can replace your spot with another eligible student)

3) If you get OSS:

- you will lose eligibility for <u>ALL</u> events
  - If you lose your eligibility we will not allow you into the event and your \$ will not be refunded (unless we can replace your spot with another eligible student)

### WHAT WILL GET YOU OSS – 100% GUARANTEED

1)Fighting (of any kind...)

2) Bringing Weapons/Drugs/Alcohol to School and or using them at school

3) Cursing at a staff member

### WHAT MAY GET YOU OSS ?

Students with prior referrals for misbehavior will be much more likely to receive OSS than students with no prior discipline history

The more referrals you have the less likely you are to be given any additional chances!

## PROMOTION TO HIGH SCHOOL IS THE GOAL...

### YOU MUST:

- PASS LANGUAGE ARTS, MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES FOR 6<sup>TH</sup>, 7<sup>TH</sup>, AND 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE (60% D OR HIGHER)
- LE YOU HAVE AN "F" FOR ONE OF THESE COURSES, YOU CAN STILL MEET PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS BY COMPLETING COURSE RECOVERY (SEE MR. DOYCHAK, MRS. DRUSCHEL OR MR. MIDDLETON) TO RECOVER THESE CLASSES BEFORE THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR
- Students who do not recover these courses by the end of the year, will <u>not</u> be promoted to HS and will be invited to ESY (Extended School Year) where they can continue to work on meeting promotion requirements
- Students who meet Promotion Requirements will receive their Promotion Certificate during the promotion Ceremony. Students who do not Meet Promotion Requirements will receive an invitation to ESY and will only receive their Promotion Certificate once they have completed course recovery and meet HS promotion requirements!!!!!
