New personnel

Personnel Changes-

Literacy initiatives will begin in the second nine weeks. The students will continue to use the AR (Renaissance) program.

Curriculum & Instruction- the team discussed traditional classroom learning and remote.

Model selection was given to the parents. The parents have until the end of the month to turn the forms in with the decision whether they want their child to continue virtual or return to the traditional school setting. The system will give advice on how to tweak things in the building to make sure that all COVID stipulations are being met.

English/ Language Arts/Math/Science/SS

The different programs were discussed that the county has purchased for the students to use. A brief description of each was given. The emphasis was on the usage of both traditional and remote students. We also talked about the district purchasing the Reflex program in math to aid with students' fact fluency after it was piloted in the previous school year.

Testing-

- Progress monitoring is to be done weekly for intensive students based on their lexile/iready
- Benchmarks are done three times a year in reading and math. The BOY benchmark has been completed.
- The proposed window for GMAS in grades 3-5 April- May 2021

Health and Safety-

Regular minders were given to cover the 3 Ws. Make sure that temp checks are being done before students enter the classroom. A health team has been identified in the school and quarantine areas have been designated.
