ELA:

Standards include:

ELACC5RF4: Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. a. Read on-level text with purpose and understanding. ELACC5W3a: Write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences or events a. Orient the reader by establishing a situation and introducing a narrator and/or characters; organize an event sequence that unfolds naturally.

ELACC5L2: e. Spell grade-appropriate words correctly, consulting references as needed

Students will continue analyzing the components of personal narratives, learning how to write in ways to better engage a reader in interesting events.

Math:

Standards include:

MGSE5.NBT.1 Recognize that in a multi-digit number, a digit in one place represents 10 times as much as it represents in the place to its right and 1/10 of what it represents in the place to its left.

MGSE5.NBT.3 Read, write, and compare decimals to thousandths. **a.** Read and write decimals to thousandths using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form, e.g., $347.392 = 3 \times 100 + 4 \times 10 + 7 \times 1 + 3 \times (1/10) + 9 \times (1/100) + 2 \times (1/1000)$.

b. Compare two decimals to thousandths based on meanings of the digits in each place, using >, =, and < symbols to record the results of comparisons. We are beginning Unit 2 this week. We will be begin with basic understandings of decimals including place value and comparing decimals. This should be mostly a review of 4th grade skills with the exception of adding the thousandths place in 5th grade.

Science/SS:

Standards include: SS5H1 Describe how life changed in America at the turn of the century.

Introducing students to the topic, "The Turn of the Century in America." Students will read content material and complete interactive notes, while gathering in information in various way in compliance with the standard.
