- > Current academic teachers must sign next to the course to approve the request. Elective teachers will approve courses that have an asterisk symbol (*). Approvals will be based on past course performance, student work ethic and standardized testing scores.
- > Students cannot pick their teachers, class periods, or lunch period.
- > If you choose an online course, be sure to indicate if you want to take it on or off campus. Students will not be permitted to have more than one period in the computer lab on campus.
- > HOPE can be deferred to sophomore year if enrolled in AP Human Geography. Please write "AP Human Geography" for this option. See counselor regarding athletic waiver or marching band waiver information and record "possible waiver" in the box.
