How is 9th Grade Different Than 8th Grade?

What's New at Elite?

- There is a GPA requirement now—2.8 GPA (What does that look like?)
- There is a disciplinary requirement now- 3 referrals= release from Elite or if the offense is deemed serious enough

How Do I Calculate My GPA?

Honors Courses: A= 4pts B= 3pts C=2 pts D=1pt F=NOTHING!!!	
AP Courses: A= 5 pts B= 4pts C=3pts D=2pts F=NOTHING!!!	
Let's Practice:	
9th Grade Lit (Honors): 85 pts	
Biology (Honors): 81 pts	
Health: 77 pts	
Geometry: 78 pts	
AP World History: 75+ 5= 80 pts	
Total Points:/the number of classes (6)= GPA (Weighted or Overall)	
Unweighted: Removes the weight of the AP class and puts the scale back on 4 instead of 5	

*99.9% of the time, the unweighted GPA is lower than the overall GPA

*GPAs do not round up; a 2.999 is not a 3.0, it is a 2.999
