

Dutchtown High School's Project Success Contract

Dutchtown Parent(s)

Your son/daughter _____ has been placed on an academic contract due to them currently failing three or more classes. The terms of the contract are listed below. I ask that you please review the terms listed below and have your child return the signed contract to Mr. Frank Jones 9th Grade Guidance Counselor by **Friday October 25, 2012**. It is important that we work together to get your child back on the right track of academic success.

Academic Contract Terms

- The student will be required to complete a weekly progress report each Friday. The students will have their teachers complete the necessary information on the weekly progress report. The progress report must be signed by the students Project Success advisor (Mr. Stephens or Mr. Jones). It is not necessary for the progress reports to be returned. The progress reports will be kept home for the parent's documentation of the student's academic progress. Failure to pick up and/or complete the weekly progress report may result in an office referral for Behavior Detrimental to Learning and a school consequence of a minimum day of ISS (In School Suspension)
- The student will **required** to attend option 1, option 2 or both of the following tutoring sessions available:
 - Option 1** - Monday through Thursday after school tutoring in the Bulldog Learning Center (BLC) from 3:30 – 4:30 p.m..
 - Or
 - Option 2** - Saturday School from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m.. Transportation can be provided for those who need it. (Student must complete the Saturday school form to enroll) Two (2) unexcused absences will result may result in an office referral for Behavior Detrimental to Learning and a school consequence of a minimum day of ISS (In School Suspension)
- The student must use the agenda book that has been given to them by writing all daily assignments from all courses in the space provided. This agenda book can be checked at any time by the students Project Success advisor. Failure to have this expectation met can result in school consequences given by the grade level administrator.
- The student must show significant improvement in their grades and meet with their Project Success advisor regularly regarding their academic progress.
- The student will follow all academic interventions provided by the school when given.

I agree and understand the terms of this contract. I also understand that failure to fulfill the contract may result in me not passing my classes and receiving the required credit for graduation.
