Students have the opportunity to participate in 4-H competitions and leadership programs at the local, regional, state and national level.</p> <p>Teasley MS eighth-grader Lillianne Cline was recently elected to Northwest District 4-H Junior Board of Directors and will represent middle school 4-H'ers from 39 different counties in her leadership position.</p> <p>Cherokee HS senior Laney Cline earned Master 4-H'er in the Fashion Revue project at State 4-H Congress and will be attending National 4-H Congress in November, as well as Master 4-H'ers in the Citizenship project and was selected as one of four delegates to represent Georgia at National 4-H Conference in Washington D.C.</p> <p>River Ridge HS sophomore Landon Fay was selected as a state-wide 4-H Wildlife Ambassador and certified in Project WILD educators to share wildlife knowledge with younger students in Cherokee County and report activities to the state on a quarterly basis.</p> <p>Woodstock HS junior Ella Perryman was elected to Northwest District 4-H Senior Board of Directors and represents high school 4-H'ers from 39 different counties in her leadership position, and she was also selected as a member of Clovers and Company state-wide 4-H performing arts group.</p>
