## Accelerated Reader / Renaissance Place™ Site License Agreement-Quizzing from Home Restrictions

What does the Site License Agreement say about quizzing from home?

- All content provided with the software can *only be used at the licensed site*<sup>1</sup> (a single-school building or single-school campus for which the school access rights have been purchased.)
- The licensee (the school or other purchasing entity) cannot allow student testing outside of the licensed site<sup>2</sup> (single-school building or single-school campus).

## Why does the Site License Agreement prohibit quizzing from home?

Quizzing from home is prohibited by the Site License Agreement for five main reasons.

- 1. Students may receive help on quizzes. While this assistance may be well intentioned, it may mask a problem that a teacher would be able to identify if the child quizzed at school.
- 2. When students quiz at home, they do not receive immediate feedback from their teachers, which is one of our best practices.
- 3. Students should be quizzing in a secure and monitored environment without the book for the most accurate measure of a child's comprehension level, which is not guaranteed at home.
- 4. Students have more opportunities when quizzing from home to copy the questions and answer choices for the purpose of sharing with others. Due to the Internet, it has become very easy for students to share quiz information. Renaissance Learning™ works hard to maintain the integrity of our quizzes and discourage copyright violations.
- 5. In Accelerated Reader™, students should be spending the vast majority of their time reading books, not taking quizzes. Book reading can occur anytime, anywhere and is not restricted by the Site License Agreement.
