In-School ACT College Reported for Grade 11

- When and Where? Tuesday, March 28, 2023 from 9:15am-1:30pm in your Period01 or assigned Test Location (see A-Z test location list on bulletin boards at car/bus gates)
- Who? 11<sup>th</sup> grade students in English 3/IB/Comp1 for the first time: You are automatically signed up for the test at no cost! Your test room was sent via schoology, on your practice book and is on the A-Z list.
- Why? ACT can give you a concordant score for the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC (score of 16+), and/or FSA ELA Writing/Reading (average score of 18 on the Reading and English subtests). It also gives students the opportunities for college applications and scholarships.
- What? The test is 3 hours (plus breaks). This test includes 4 sections: Reading, English, Math w/ a calculator (must bring your own approved calculator no cell phones/smart watches).



- Snacks/lunch/Water and personal test materials, including pencils & calculators, <u>need to be provided by the student</u>. If you buy lunch/FRL, let the cafeteria know in advance so they can prepare your lunch. If you need to leave after testing, parent permission is required by 3/24/2023 at this link: https://www-pmhs.stjohns.k12.fl.us/attendance/
- Students will fill out/bubble in their personal information and will need to know their mailing address, email address, and date of birth (DOB).
