

## Adding a Podcast to Your Webpage

Podcasting simply refers to audio or video files which are provided on the Internet. To create or listen to a podcast, you do not need an ipod or mp3 player. To create a podcast, you need a microphone and a computer.

There are 2 ways to add a podcast to your SchoolCenter webpage:

1. *Audio only* podcasts can be added in the same way you would add an image on a webpage.
2. Put it in your document manager.

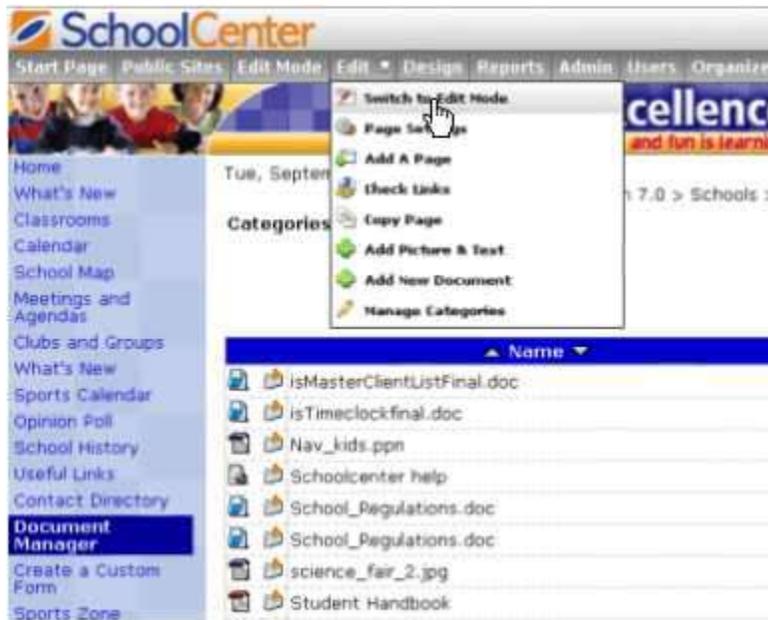
### Adding a Podcast to your Document Manager

---

You can add podcasts to your site through the Document Manager

#### 1. Document Manager

- From your Document Manager, Select Switch to Edit Mode from the Edit drop-down menu.



- Select Page Settings from the Edit drop-down menu.

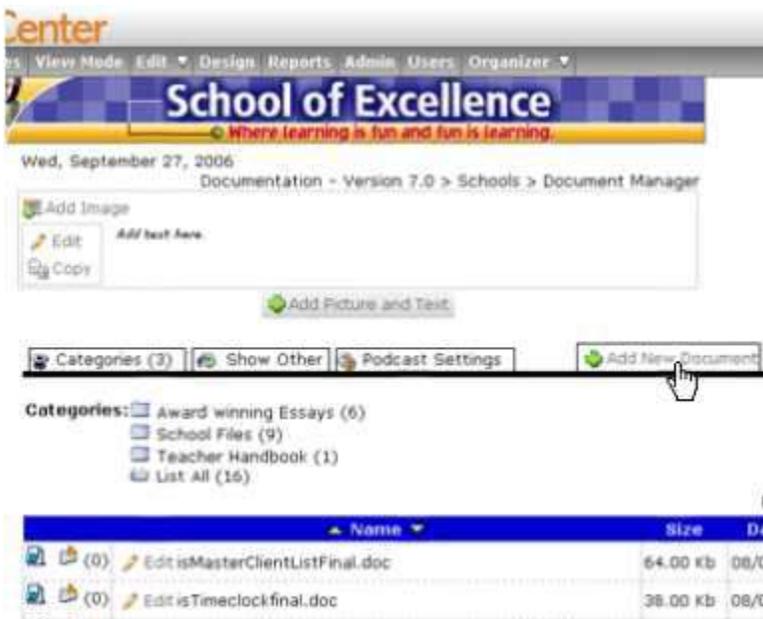


- To Enable Podcast Support, select the Enable podcast support box.
- When you are finished with your Page Settings, click on the Done button.

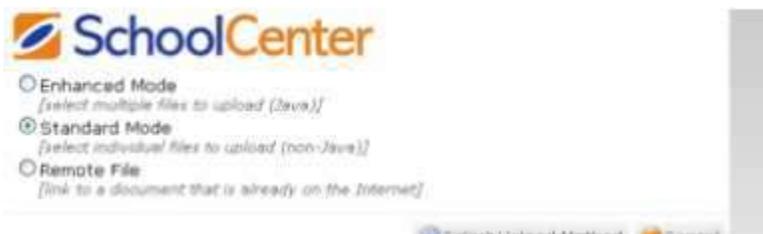


## 2. Add New Document

- To start adding a Podcast to your page, click on the Add New Document button.



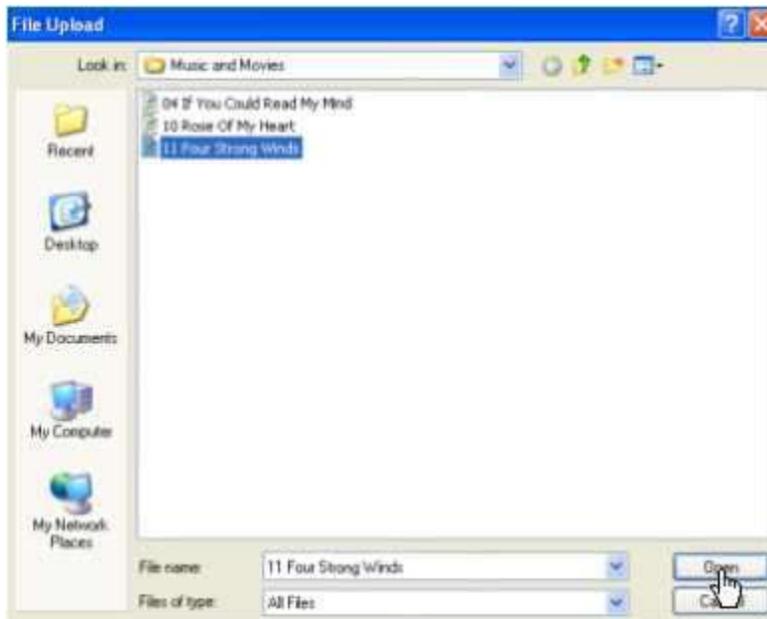
- The Upload New Document window will open.
- Select a Mode for the Document and then click on the Select Upload Method button.



- To add a music or video file from your hard drive, click on the Browse... button.



- You will see a window similar to this one (depending on your computer). Select the media you wish to add.
- Then click on the Open button.



- You have the option to Cancel at anytime.
- Click on the Done button.



### 3. Podcast Settings

- Your Edit Document window will open.
- You have the option to Edit your Document if you wish.
- Once you are finished editing your document, click on the Done button.



- To set up Settings for your Podcast, click on the Podcast Settings button.



- The Podcast Settings window will appear.
- Enter in a Title for your Podcast.
- Fill out a Description for the Podcast into the Description box.
