

#### **Example of HOPE Scholarship GPA from high school counselors:**

- The LTC accepted Report is called a "Detailed Student Calculations Report" printed from a counselor from the GSFC website.
- Must be sent from a trusted source to the college (i.e. counselor email, fax, etc.) and must indicated Grade Level 11 or higher.
  - If Grade Level 10 is indicated on the report, of which some 11<sup>th</sup> grade reports "may" reflect, the counselor (trusted source from high school) must indicate on the grade report, by initial, or by official email, the student is indeed in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade.



The following information is based on the most recent transcript record provided by your high school:




Academic Rigor Credits earned (4 credits are required by High School Graduation): 2

To qualify for the Zell Miller Scholarship, acceptable SAT or ACT scores must have been earned prior to high school graduation and submitted to GSFC. To be eligible you must have at least a 26 composite score on the ACT or have at least a 1200 for Math and Reading on the SAT on one date.
