
## Forsyth County Schools' Typical Paths with flexibility options curriculum:



- 1. Students moving from 6th on-level to 7th advanced complete FCS itslearning Transition Course (2 units of 7th grade math)
- Students moving from 6th advanced to 7th accelerated complete FCS itslearning Transition Course (3 units of 7th grade math)
- 3. Students moving from 7th on-level to Algebra I complete Edgenuity Transition Course (addressing key grade 8 standards)
- Students moving from Algebra I to Accel B complete FVA Summer Geometry A Course (High School Course, 0.5 credit)
