AP courses are considered college level courses, in which students can possibly earn an additional 1.0 weighted value grade point for each AP course they complete and take the exam for as well as possibly earning college credit. Students should expect 1 to 2 hours of home study for every hour spent in class. Successful completion of the course will prepare students for the AP exam in the corresponding subject. For most students, there is an adjustment period in the beginning of the course, however, most students adjust to the rigor and learn to perform at a satisfactory level or above.
