



Advanced Placement Contract 2021-2022 Academic Year

AP courses are considered college level courses, in which students can possibly earn an additional 1.0 weighted value grade point for each AP course they complete and take the exam for as well as possibly earning college credit. Students should expect 1 to 2 hours of home study for every hour spent in class. Successful completion of the course will prepare students for the AP exam in the corresponding subject. For most students, there is an adjustment period in the beginning of the course, however, most students adjust to the rigor and learn to perform at a satisfactory level or above.

By initialing below, I understand the requirements of enrolling in this/these Advanced Placement Course (s); and my parents/guardian and I agree to the following terms:

- ___ 1. The demands of an AP course exceed those of a general college prep courses, and I am committed to the extra effort needed to succeed in each course.
- ___ 2. I understand that an AP course is a yearlong commitment and it is an expectation that I will not withdraw from this AP course at the end of the first semester.
- ___ 3. I understand that I must abide by the conditions set forth in the Course syllabus (e.g., attendance, grading and make-up policies)
- ___ 4. After reading the course descriptions/syllabus for each AP course, I am confident that I have the skills and dedication necessary to be successful in the course listed below.
- ___ 5. AP exams will now be ordered in October. Any student who is withdrawn for failure at the semester from an AP course AFTER October 1st will be required to pay \$144 for their AP exam and the unused exam fee.
- ___ 6. All AP students commit to taking the AP exam offered in May. If a student does not show or is late for his/her AP exam they are required to pay \$144 for the exam and the unused exam fee.
- ___ 7. I understand that I must report to my exam at least 30 minutes prior to the exam start time (7:30 AM or 11:30 PM). Late arrivals will not be permitted to test, per College Board policy.
