

Spanish Informal Commands

Commands - telling somebody to DO something!

Commands are when you are telling (not asking!) somebody to DO something. Here are patterns for someone you would call “tú.” Commands are important because if you go to a Spanish speaking country, they are one of the first things you will listen to!



Practice saying the following commands in their affirmative forms

llamar <small>call</small>	llama
tomar <small>take</small>	toma
comer <small>eat</small>	come
ver <small>see</small>	ve
dormir <small>sleep</small>	duerme
escribir <small>write</small>	escribe

Intro to Informal Commands (mandatos informales)

The following is meant as a supplement to the p 82 book explanation of tú commands. It can't hurt to see it all one more time:

I. Mandatos afirmativos: Affirmative tú commands are pretty easy. You simply use the regular THIRD PERSON ([él/ella/Ud.](#)) form of the verb:

Yo quiero cantar --> Pues, [¡canta!](#)
Yo quiero vivir --> Pues, [¡vive!](#)

There are nine common verbs that have irregular tú command forms:

decir --> di **salir --> sal** **ser --> sé**

hacer --> haz **poner --> pon** **ir --> ve**

tener --> ten **venir --> ven**

III. Posiciones de los pronombres y complementos: This is the same with Ud. commands: direct object, indirect object, and reflexive pronouns **are attached to affirmative commands.** (Affirmative = **yes**, you **do** attach pronouns.) You will need to write in an accent mark if adding the pronoun(s) makes the affirmative command more than two syllables long. The stress stays on the verb stem.

Ejemplos:

- Mira tu examen. → Míralo.
- Ponte los zapatos. → Póntelos.
- Pon la mesa. → Ponla
