- We offer various extracurricular clubs and activities on our campus, which give students the opportunity to participate in various programs in academics, arts, or athletics.
- We are proud to offer a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Mathematics) Program of Enrichment with MakerSpace, allowing students to design their thinking through exploring their creativity through various unique projects, robotics, and art programs.

2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **57%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **51%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **51%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.

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- All 5th grade students benefit from STEM lab classrooms for math and science.
- Altamonte has regular family events and encourages active participation in our SAC and PTA.
- Altamonte Elementary is a model school for building enhancements that provide a safe learning environment.
- Students have enrichment opportunities such as Running Club, Reading Clubs, Math Clubs, Student Council, Lego Robotics, Odyssey of the Mind, Safety Patrols and News Crew.
- Students produce a musical experience each fall and spring which include various forms of the Fine Arts.
- Technology is integrated into all classrooms using various devices and interactive boards to enhance the students' learning experiences.
