In addition, students need to select an additional book(s) according to their Lexile level range (found on the CRCT results) totaling a minimum of 250 pages and complete their Reading Agreement for each additional book read. Students should choose books they have not previously read. Students may use the suggested list of authors and some of their novel titles below from which to choose their books; however, students are not limited to the authors and titles listed.
