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### **Process Steps**

- **Step 1.** Review content standards from completed *Targeted Content Standards Template* and insert content strand(s) into specification table.
- **Step 2.** Determine the number of items by item type (i.e., Multiple Choice, Short Constructed Response, Extended Constructed Response) for each content strand.
- **Step 3.** Ensure item type and cognitive level (I, II, III)/depths of knowledge (DoK) are assigned.

**Step 4.** Assign item weights to each item type.

Step 5. Assign number of passages (by type) when using literary works.

### **QA Checklist**

- □ There is a sufficient sampling of targeted standards.
- □ The specifications reflect a balance between developmental readiness and time constraints.
- □ Time is considered for both educators and students.
- □ The cognitive demands reflect those articulated in the targeted standards.
- □ The measure allows for both objective and subjective scoring procedures.
- □ The measure consists of 35-50 points with the Level I/DoK I limited to one-third of the items/tasks.

### **Process Steps**
