- 2) The completed application must include a minimum of a 450 and maximum of 500 word typed essay on the topic “What can you personally do to promote Americanism in your school or community?” Emphasis on the American Flag**
- 3) Applicants will need to demonstrate qualities of service, leadership and character. They must contribute to the success of their school and community.**
