




1743 – 1826

 Helped urge Congress to declare independence during the Revolution








1738 – 1820

Independence








1737 – 1809

# Crispus Attucks


1723 – 1770

1738 – 1895

Yorktown








- 1742 1786

#### Nathan Hale

1755 – 1776
Patriot spy during the Revolutionary War
Was caught by the British and hanged







1757 – 1834
French soldier
Came to America before the Battle of Saratoga and joined

### Baron von Steuben

1730 - 1794Prussian soldier Helped train American soldiers during the winter at Valley Forge during the American Revolution


