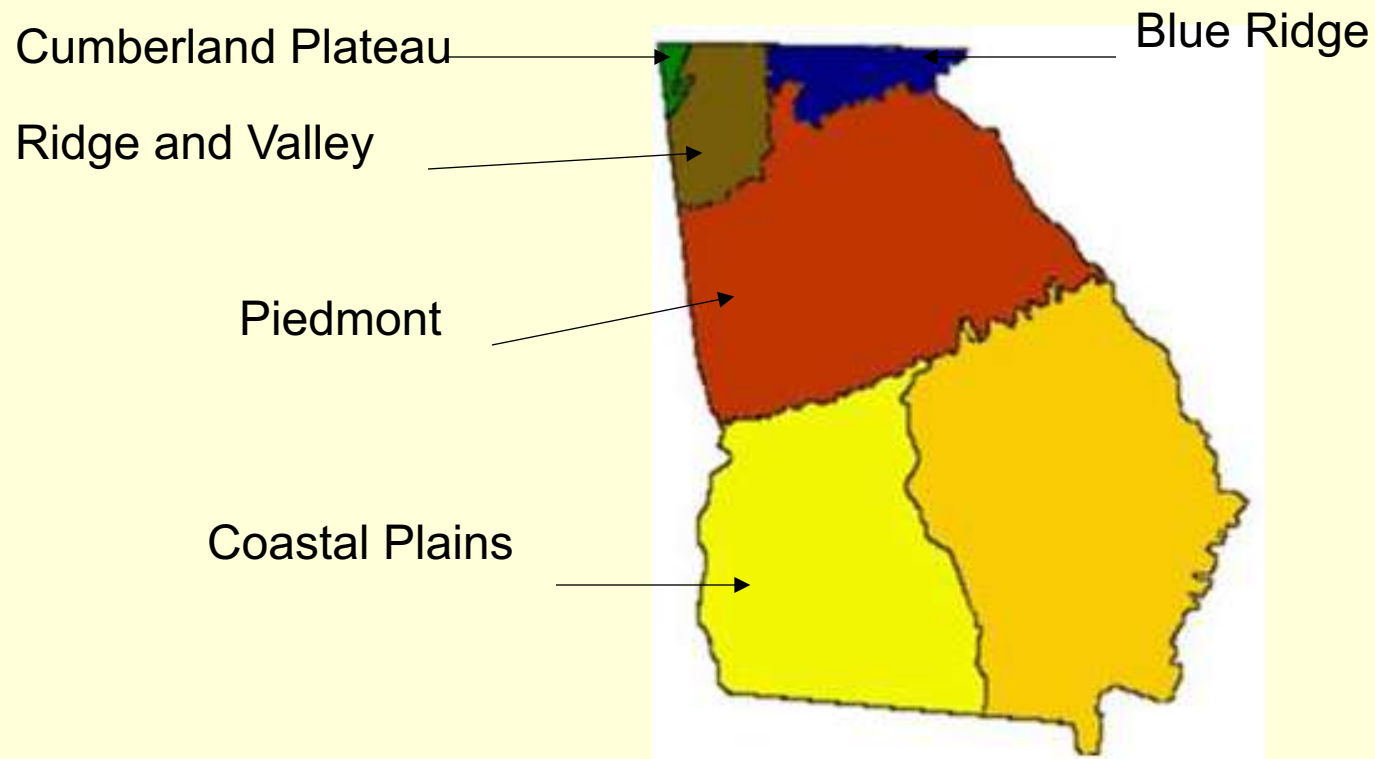

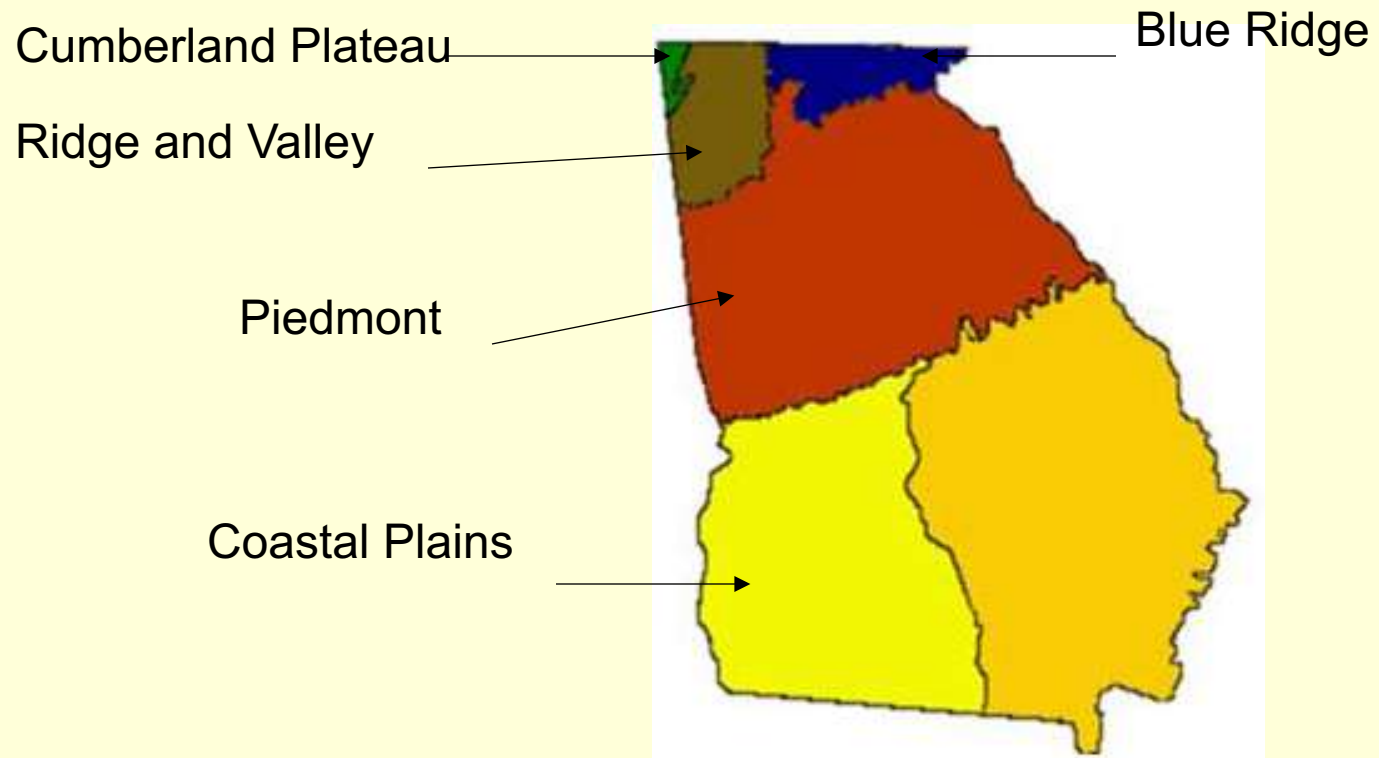
# Mountain

# Drought



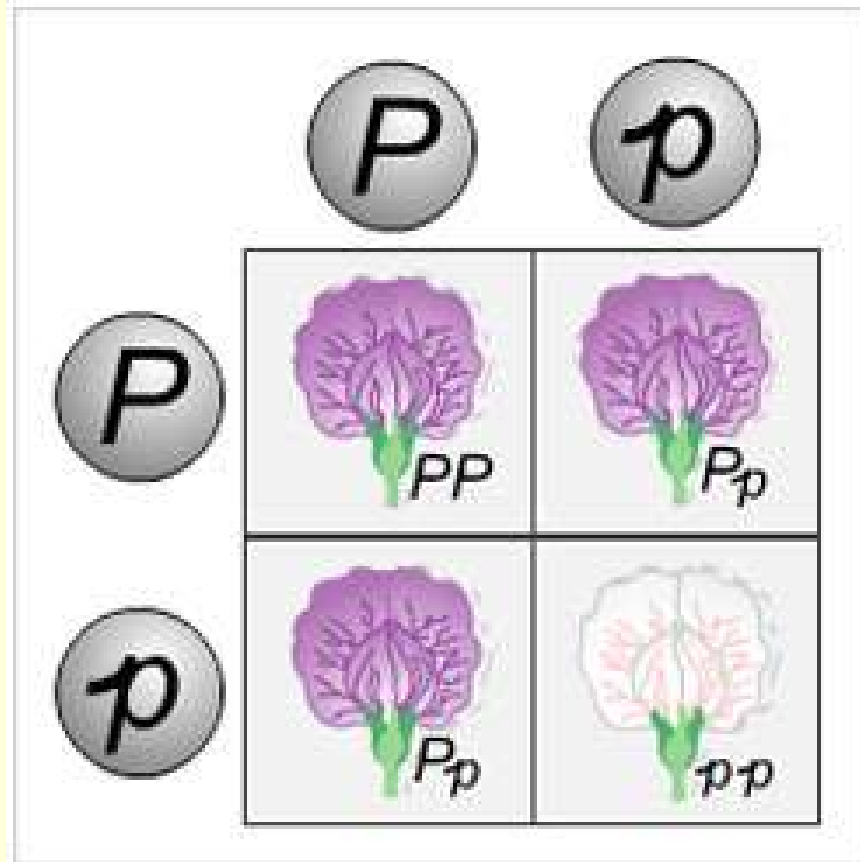
What do we call everything that surrounds a living thing?



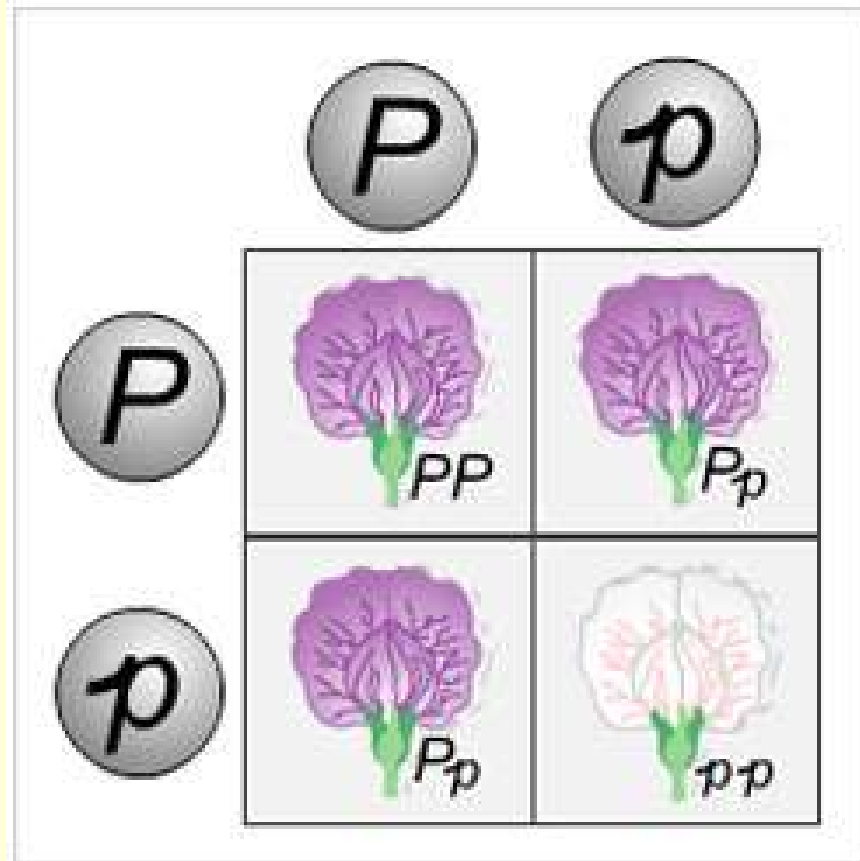
# Environment

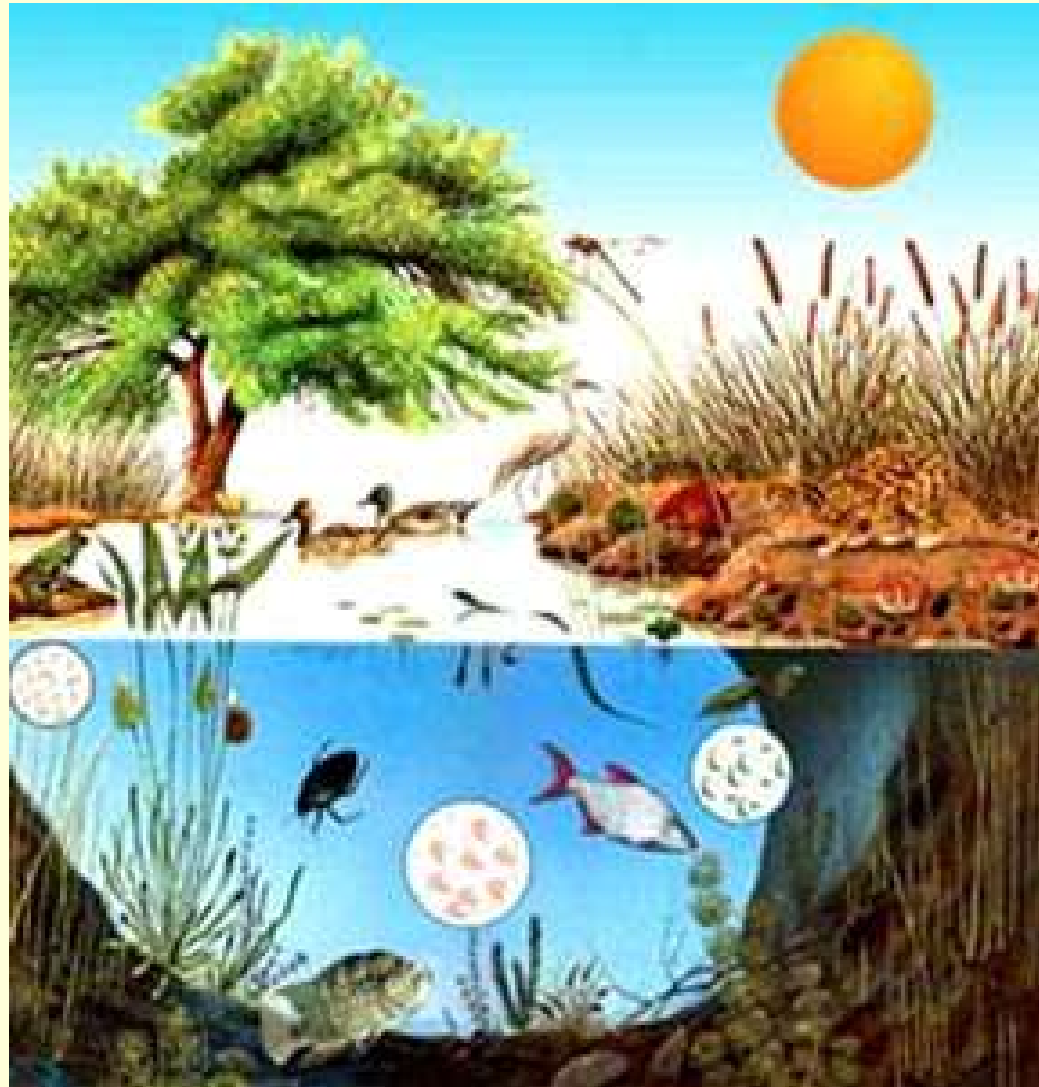

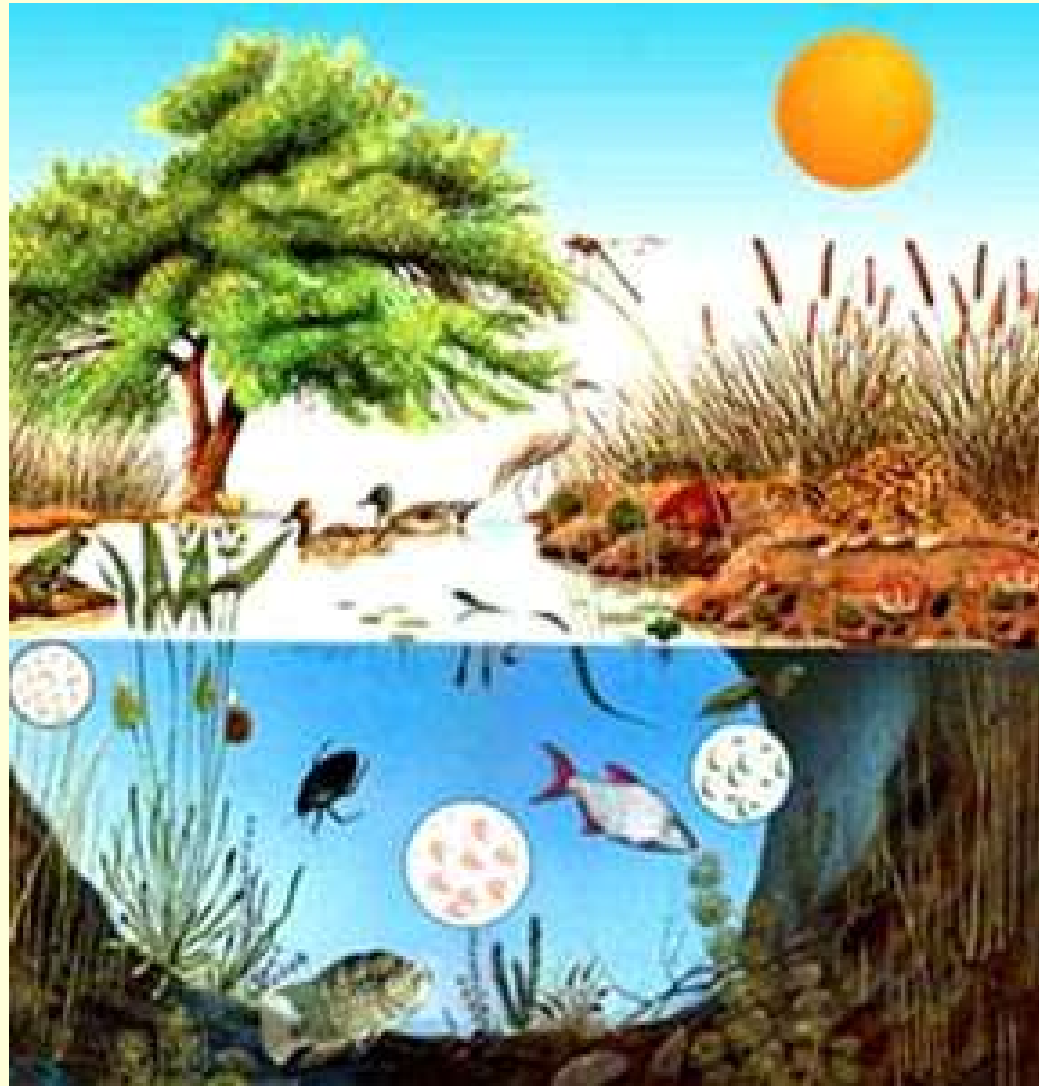
