Drawings will be judged on the following:

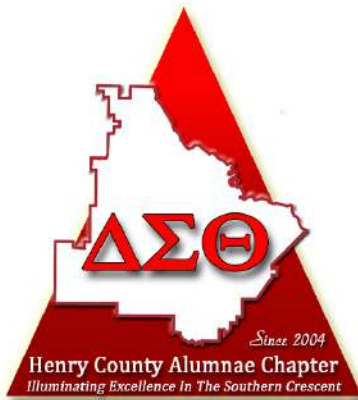
- How well the artwork represents modern agriculture found in the student's county

Beginning with the Class of 2022, families with a total income of less than \$60,000 and assets typical of this income range will have a parent or guardian contribution of \$0.

This new policy expands upon our longstanding practice of meeting 100 percent of each admitted student's demonstrated financial need without loans. More than 90 percent of families with a total income of \$200,000 or less have qualified for some form of financial assistance in recent years, and our average financial aid award for enrolling students is more than \$46,000.
