### Senior Student Scholarship

Graduating public high school seniors are eligible to apply for a \$1,000 Pasco Art of Recycling scholarship at [ww.pascoeducationfoundation.org](http://ww.pascoeducationfoundation.org). Students must have a 2.0 GPA, be enrolled in a program for art or environmental science, and must have entered artwork during the 2015 or any of the previous three (3) Pasco Art of Recycling contests (Applications will be verified). See your guidance counselor for more info on the Scholarship application deadline.

### Awards and Certificates

Winners of the Pasco Art of Recycling competition will be announced during the week of **February 9-13, 2015** at their schools with awards and certificates being presented at that time. This will give students and staff from the individual's school an opportunity to congratulate the winners immediately following their notification.

### Art Drop-Off

To submit your art to the art exhibit, it must first be chosen to be among the seven (7) entries to represent your school. Complete this application, have your art teacher initial in the appropriate space. The teacher must indicate that your art piece is among the seven (7) chosen, then tape this completed application directly to your art and bring both to the West Pasco County Government Center, County Commission Board Room lobby located at 8731 Citizens Drive, New Port Richey, 34654 on **Friday Jan. 30, 2015 from 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.** . All art must be submitted on this day and during these times only! No exceptions.

*The Pasco Art of Recycling Committee consists of The District School Board of Pasco County, Pasco Arts Council, and Pasco County Recycling and Facilities.*

### Exhibition Rules

- Each school is limited to a total of seven (7) pieces.
- Individual schools will determine which pieces are entered.
- Art must reflect an environmental theme and have a title.
- Art teacher MUST initial application in the space after their name and confirm the art piece is one of the seven selected to represent the school.
- Art must be no larger than 42-inches in any one direction.
- Two-dimensional art must be equipped with a secure hanging wire, no saw-tooth hangers are allowed.
- Three-dimensional art must be free-standing, sturdy, ready for display, completely assembled, and sturdy enough to move.
- Student must designate whether they are donating (recommended option) art or if they will pick-up their art.
- One art entry allowed per student. No group art will be accepted.
- Art submitted in previous Art of Recycling competitions is not eligible.
- At least 70% of the materials used in the creation of your art must be constructed of recycled, discarded, or used materials and listed below.
- Art cannot present a safety hazard while on display. Art entries that are no longer able to free-stand, are falling apart, etc. will be discarded at the discretion of the committee. Art Teachers will be notified.
- All media are encouraged. Entries can include painting, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, wearable art, architecture and any other creation.
- Art cannot depict violence, nudity or inappropriate themes or images.
- During check-in, art will not be accepted unless delivered by the artist or art teacher. Artist/teacher must stay until check-in process is complete. DROP AND GO ART WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Student must attend a public, private, or home-school high school in Pasco County to participate.
- Only public school students are eligible for the scholarship.
- Judges will decide which art entries will be displayed in the exhibition.
- All judges decisions are final.
