Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Advanced Placement program provides high school students with an opportunity to experience college level course work while in high school and to gain college credit through participating universities by earning an accepted score on the AP exam. If your son/daughter is enrolled in at least one advanced placement course we would like to inform you of the schedule and procedures associated with taking the exams. This year's exams are scheduled according to the calendar at the bottom of this letter.

Wiregrass Ranch High School students have been provided with additional registration information during the AP Preadministration Sessions. Please note, a student will NOT be able to participate in taking the exams if they have not completed the registration.

Wiregrass Ranch High covers the \$91 exam cost for each student. If a student misses the exam for any reason, and has to participate in the exam make-up, they must pay WRHS to cover the cost of the exam and the fee that the College Board charges. If a student has two exams scheduled for the same date and time, they should notify, me, Mrs. Butcher immediately to make alternate arrangements.

At this time, we are providing you with the schedule of exams and the procedures associated so that you can plan ahead and prepare for this upcoming activity. Students are required to arrive at the testing site no later than 30 minutes prior to the exam: 7:30 a.m. for the morning administration; 11:30 a.m. for the afternoon administration. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended. Please note: afternoon exams may not conclude until 4:30 p.m., so plan accordingly.

Students are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Wiregrass Ranch High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize the student's AP Exam grade. Be sure to review the *Bulletin for Students and Parents*.
