Dear MCHS AP Second Semester Student & Parent,

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Morgan County High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. AP Exams are given in May. Morgan County High School will send out a testing schedule closer to the exam period.

Exam registration/payments for students taking AP Spring classes will begin on **Monday, January 10, 2022 and will end on Friday, March 11, 2022**. Students will enroll in their course through the myap.collegeboard.org website. If they have taken AP classes in the past, they should already have an account. If they are taking their first AP class, they will need to create an account. They will need a Class Code to register; they can obtain the Class Code from their AP teacher or from their Media Specialist - Mrs. Coleman.

The cost for an AP exam is \$96.00. All exam fees will be paid to the school. Exam fees can be paid by cash, check, or credit card. If paying by check, please make the check out to Morgan County High School. All payments can be processed by Kaylee Coleman in the Media Center. When making your payment, please indicate the exam(s) you are paying for.

Here are the important dates to remember:

- Monday, January 10, 2022 - **Exam Payment/Registration for Spring courses begin**
- Friday, March 11, 2022 - **LAST DAY to pay/register for AP Spring course exam(s)**
