Assignment: Using the dialectical journaling format (sample and instructions can be found on the teachers' websites), complete journal entries for the following topics:

1. **Five** entries for McCandless' attitude toward a flawed society: Note "attitude".
2. **Five** entries for society's attitude toward McCandless, as reflected by people who knew him. DO NOT include the author, Krakauer.
3. **Five** entries for Krakauer's attitude toward McCandless.

\*Journals will not be assigned a grade in the gradebook, but will be used to complete our first analysis essay at the start of the school year.

Note: every journal entry must be accompanied with FULL commentary. The journal is a map of your thoughts; therefore, incomplete commentary depicts incomplete thought.
