Liberty Pines Academy Application Process

In order to be considered for membership into the Liberty Pines Academy Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, you must follow all instructions.

1. Applications will be available for current 6th and 7th graders beginning **Tuesday, April 11, 2023** and can be picked up from your homeroom teacher.
2. Completed forms **MUST** be returned to Mrs. Delaney at the Front Office by **Tuesday, April 25, 2023 by 2:30 p.m.**
3. A faculty selection committee appointed by the Principal, consisting of five (5) faculty members, will review the applications and recommendations for final selections.
4. Students **selected** for membership will be invited, with their families, to attend the Induction Ceremony Fall of 2023.

Deadline for application: 2:30 p.m. on April 25, 2023.

**** PLEASE NOTE: LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ****

The application form must include:

- Rights and Responsibility Form
- Copy of your **most recent report card**: The report card is used to determine if you meet the GPA requirement of a 3.5. GPA **does not** guarantee acceptance into the National Junior Honor Society program. You must print the Report Card from HAC – the front office will not print report cards for you.
- Leadership Form
- Service Form
- Citizenship Form
- Character Form
- **Four** teacher recommendation forms: It is **your responsibility** to put your name on the forms. You can only use **one** recommendation from a previous year's teacher.
