

Studies show that people who do at least 5 acts of kindness over 6 weeks increased their levels of happiness on average by 41.66%.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Positive friends are people in your life that encourage us, are there for us and help us to be our best selves. They don't encourage us to participate in negative behaviors nor do they put us down. <p>Let's practice generosity with positive friends! At this time advisors will distribute small "thank you" cards for students to give to a friend. Please think about a positive friend in your life and send them a little note of appreciation.</p>

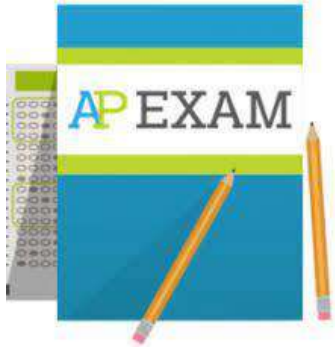

Each exam will be \$97
Free/Reduced Lunch **1 free exam**, each additional exam **\$54**
1 free AP STEM exam (Math or Science)
Cancel or Unused Exam - \$40
