Take Your Child to Work Day

For parents not employed by Pasco County Schools:

The national Take Your Daughters and Sons to Work day is scheduled for Thursday, April 28. That day falls during state end-of-course exams. With this in mind, we will use the same process we've used the past couple of years for parents who wish to take their children to work with them at their place of employment outside the district. A principal has the discretion to allow a parent to take his or her son or daughter out of school to participate in the national event if the student does not have a scheduled EOC on Thursday, April 28, AND the parent has prearranged the student's absence with his or her principal and teacher(s).

For parents employed by Pasco County Schools:

District employees who wish to bring their son or daughter to work with them may do so on Friday, May 27. Employees also must prearrange their children's absences with their principals and teachers if they plan to participate on May 27. They also must get approval from their site administrator. Schools and departments should use their newsletters and other platforms for communicating with parents to let them know their responsibilities. Take Your Daughters and Sons to Work Day generally is for elementary- and middle school-age children.
