#### Attention parents of rising 6th graders

Please watch for your online Returning Student Verification (RSV) email coming the week of April 11, 2022. Three proofs of residency are required to be uploaded with the RSV in order to complete your student's registration for middle school. No schedules will be issued by Fruit Cove Middle School until this step is completed!

If your student has medication at the school there will be a sign up genius sent out to sign up for a time to pick up meds during the last 2 days of school. Next year's forms will be placed on the clinic website in late May so that they can be completed over the summer and ready for next school year.
