

subtraction within 1,000.


Please continue to practice addition and subtraction facts. This will be very helpful when we start this final unit in math.

#### SCIENCE


We are studying structure and functions of plants and animals. This includes learning about many of the organs in the human body!

The survey will ask how likely you are to recommend our school to others and will provide an opportunity for you to tell us about your experience.


