
Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries. The organization is to help members develop policies on oil production, prices and trade that will benefit its members

Explain how most countries have a mixed economy located on a continuum between pure market and pure command.

A mixed economy has elements of command and market economic systems. There is government control and individual freedoms to decide the three basic economic questions.

Compare and contrast the economic systems in Israel, Saudi Arabia and Turkey.

Israel (government and private companies own and control the economy) and Saudi Arabia (royal family and the government both control the economy) both have mixed economies, Turkey (government controls the economy) has mostly a command economy.



Countries specialize in trading because of unequal distribution of global resources. Exporting and importing certain goods and services they need helps to successfully run their economies




Describe how the mountain, desert, and water features affect population in terms of where people live, type of work they do and how they travel?

What are the types of governments in Israel, Saudi Arabia and Iran?









This Middle Eastern country borders the Sinai Peninsula and Egypt to its east, Jordan to its west and Lebanon to it north.




Compare and contrast the prominent religions in Southwest Asia (Middle East): Judaism, Islam, and Christianity.





The U.S. has interest in Persian Gulf conflict because Iraq invaded Kuwait. The United States and its allies demanded that Iraq withdraw troops from Kuwait or face attacks.



the September 11, 2001 attacks (World Trade Center in New York, Pentagon in Virginia and crashed airplane in Pennsylvania) by al-Qaeda (radical terrorists) on the United States. President George W. Bush called on other countries to help wage a war on terrorism. The first goal was to find the attack organizer Osama bin Laden believed to be in Afghanistan



The U.S. suspected Iraq has weapons of mass destruction and would connect with terrorist and to free Iraq's people from accused terrorist Saddam Hussein (Iraq's Dictator).

What is the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) and its role in the Israeli and Arab Conflicts?


The PLO was formed in 1964 to take Palestine back from the Israelis. There have been a series of wars and events that have kept Palestinians and Israelis from having peace.


Types of Governments \$100

A form of government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised directly by them or by their elected agents under a free electoral system.



Types of Government \$200

A government system encompassing several states or political divisions, in which the component states retain considerable independence.
