### **INFORMATION:**

**Art Club** is an accelerated class offered by Mrs. McClung on Thursdays after school. It is a chance to expand the skills of young artists. Art Club is open to interested students who are **fourth and fifth graders** THIS YEAR. Art club fee (\$25) will cover all art materials used.

Applications start *August 19th* and must be returned by *August 26th*. Students will be notified if they are selected for Art Club by <u>August 30<sup>th</sup></u>. The Art Club will meet from 2:50 - 3:50 pm on Thursdays. Art Club will be limited to 20 students, from each grade level who submit their completed application by the deadline. If there are more than 20 applications submitted, students will be placed on a waiting list. Attendance will be taken at each meeting. If a student is absent twice, another student from the waiting list will be given their spot.

Art Club will meet every other Thursday from 2:50 – 3:50 pm; starting Thursday, September 5<sup>th</sup>.
