#### Purpose:

During this time of uncertainty, it is important that students feel a sense of hope. Expression of hope though the Arts are a great way to allow students to process their feelings and emotions about our current state of events and positively reframe feelings of hope.

#### **Guidelines:**

Students are encouraged to create works of art to express their feelings of hope during this time of social distancing and unrest. This art can be in the form of the following:

- Visual Art: original paintings, drawings, sculptures, etc.
- Music: an original or arrangement of a vocal or instrumental piece (2 min. max.)
- Theatre: a monologue, spoken word, poetry writing or reading, a skit, etc.
- Dance: a choreographed performance (2 min. max)

Credit to the author, artist, or originator work must be cited if not original.

#### Criteria

- Works of art in design, concept, and execution
- Artistically, visually aesthetically appealing
- Connected to the theme: The Art of Hope, Henry's Hope
- Appropriate for public viewing
- No explicit lyrics
- Attire that adheres to school dress code policy (Exception dance costume)

#### **Submission Process:**

Students will submit their original work via Google Forms using the link provided by their teacher.
