Program Description:

- Two, 90-minute structured hands-on/topic specific workshops per month
- Two, weekly classroom observations per month (up to 60 min.) related to the prior training's content
- Trainings supplemented with brief readings and assignments
- Instructors are BCBA and/or Ph.D.-level subject matter experts in autism, PBIS and educational programming
- Syllabus/program binder provided; students purchase text book "ABA for Teachers, 9th Edition"
- Knowledge assessments/scored assignments determine content acquisition at end of all training modules
- Competency checks determine performance acquisition
- Program content is highly consistent with Devereux's D-PBIS approach

Graduation Requirements:

Certification will be earned if a student ...

- Attends 90 percent or more scheduled meetings, or completes a self-study assignment if a meeting is missed (this is allowed for a maximum of three meetings)
- Meets mastery criteria for direct observation measures, including observation checklists
- Averages a score of 85 percent or higher on knowledge assessments
- Meets mastery criteria for performance checklists related to assignments
- Has fully met all financial requirements
